



OUCARES Evening Enrichment: Dealing with Trauma and Toxic Stress to Best Support You and Your Family – Thursday, October 21

The Joanne and Ted Lindsay Foundation Autism Outreach Services (OUCARES) will be holding an OUCARES Evening Enrichment on Thursday, October 21 from 6–7 p.m. Attendees will have the opportunity to strengthen their understanding of the impact of trauma and how it affects the brain, with a focus on how trauma impacts children's behaviors and the effects of the Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) on children later in life.

This free webinar is designed for parents and caregivers of individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), professionals who work with those individuals, or anyone interested in learning how to support individuals with ASD.
