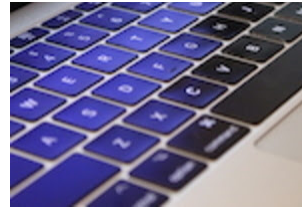


Academic Advising Available Remotely

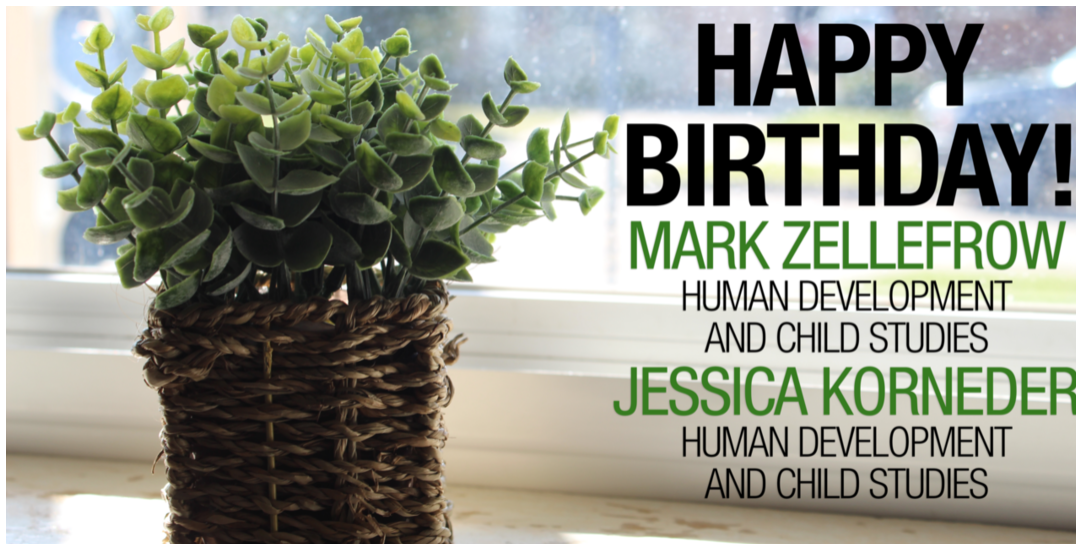


Please remind your students that, while the SEHS Advising office is closed, their services are still available remotely. Students can schedule web-based advising appointments through Google Meet.
