Mr. Dutton explained the decision of the Committee in taking the above action as it affected the Sociology Department recommendations by reading the Senate rule regarding the procedure for recommending students for departmental honors. The Chairman of the Sociology Department, who was made aware of the Committee's decision, stated he or a representative of the department would be present at this meeting to ask for a waiver of the one-third limitation in order to recommend two candidates for departmental honors. Mr. Hetenyi moved that the Senate direct a letter to the chairman of the Sociology Department informing him of the Senate's action regarding the department's recommendations for departmental honors. (The letter was to also inform the chairman that this decision can be reviewed at the next Senate meeting, August 17, if the department wishes to send a representative to make a case for the recommendations.)
