### V. Thandi Sulé Publishes Article with Recent DOL Graduates

Dr. V. Thandi Sulé, associate professor in the Department of Organizational Leadership and Master of Education in Higher Education Leadership (MAHEL) coordinator, recently published an article with two recent SEHS graduates for *Teachers College Record*. Sulé collaborated with Dr. Tiffany Williams and Dr. Michelle Nelson on the article, titled "They #Woke: How Black Students in an After-School Community-Based Program Manifest Critical Consensus."

The article explores how critical consciousness manifests among Black youth participants in an after-school program that is grounded in Africentric values and reflective of critical race theory principles. It can be read in its entirety <u>online</u>.

Additionally, Williams was recently appointed director of diversity and inclusion for Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine, and Nelson recently started a new position as DEI postdoctoral research fellow at Lawrence Technological University; Nelson is also a recent recipient of the Howard Hughes Medical Institute Inclusive Excellence Grant.
