## Minutes of the Formal Session of the Oakland University Board of Trustees December 9, 2019

#### A. Call to Order

Chair W. David Tull called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. in Banquet Room A of the Oakland Center.

#### B. Roll Call

Mr. Victor A. Zambardi, Vice President for Legal Affairs, General Counsel and Secretary to the Board of Trustees, conducted a roll call and all of the Board members were present, except for Trustee Robert Schostak, who arrived at 2:06 p.m., and Trustee Melissa Stolicker.

#### C. President's Report

President Pescovitz began her report with a recap of her State of the University address from October. She described the State of the University as very strong, represented by the fact that FTIAC (first time in any college) applications, admissions and enrollments continue to be at record highs. New transfer students are up 10% over 2018 and the class is the most academically successful and talented ever. Oakland's Carnegie designation went from an R-3 designation to R-2, a recognition that is held by just 3.1% of all universities nationwide. This summer's Presidential Retreat focused on research and the desire to increase research productivity to enable Oakland to increase its economic impact and engagement in the community. The financial state of the University is strong as exemplified by Oakland's Moody's Rating, which is and continues to be A-1 Stable. The endowment has grown to \$106.5 million with endowment returns exceeding Oakland's peers.

Next, she highlighted community engagement efforts, including the Center for Civic Engagements program called "Women in the Legislature" for women who are active in the legislature. Representative Elissa Slotkin participated in a program about women in the legislature, which was open to the entire community and a second program was a collaborative program between the

Center for Civic Engagement and the Varner Vitality Lecture, which included Lech Wałęsa, the past President of Poland and a Noble Laureate and was attended by nearly 1,200 people. The Braun Lecture featured internationally renowned artist Maria Magdalena Campos-Pons who gave four different presentations across campus.

President Pescovitz noted that the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE) presented Oakland with a Gold Award for the "Aspire. Advance. Achieve." comprehensive campaign case statement and a second Gold Award for the "Aspire. Advance. Achieve." launch video, which beat out second place Penn State and third place University of Michigan. Oakland also received a Silver Award for "A Visit with Curtis Armstrong" and a Bronze Award for "Results of a Legacy: The Linzi Hobbs Story." Oakland received the 2019 Excellence and Innovation Award for Leadership Development from the American Association for State Colleges and Universities (AASCU) for the Oakland University Leadership Academy. Finally, she noted that Oakland has become the first Michigan Division I school to establish a varsity esports program, partnering with the Renegades professional esports organization. She feels that this is an entrepreneurial approach that will enhance student learning and will enable Oakland to expand its programs, including computer science, graphic design, communications, art and music, while increasing student engagement.

Vice President for University Advancement Mike Westfall provided a community engagement update. President Pescovitz gave a charge to develop a university peer-based recognition program that spotlighted community service by empowering every full-time benefit eligible employee to recognize others for the great work that they do on campus or in the community. With this charge, and by utilizing the existing Carrot Application, a health and wellness app that Human Resources currently uses, a pilot peer recognition program was launched over the summer for the Administrative Professional employment group. They were able to secure \$50,000 in sponsorship funding from the OU Credit Union to cover all of the expenses and a marketing plan was developed for the all-campus launch, which is going to happen in January. Mr. Westfall presented an overview of the app and functionality that was added to give the user the opportunity to nominate a coworker or a colleague for an award, which is a \$5 gift card. President Pescovitz added that the app roll out will be around the same time as the new values statement.

Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and Director of the School of Music, Theater and Dance Amy Tully provided an overview of the School of Music, Theatre and Dance and its mission to provide pre-professional, professional, liberal arts, and general education in the performing arts through artistically-grounded academic programs and diverse performance opportunities. She presented on the available careers for students in the performing arts and the economic impact of the arts both nationally and in the state of Michigan. She concluded by presenting data on Oakland students in the School and community engagement involvement, including its involvement in the OU-Pontiac Initiative, community music program, its study abroad programs, and philanthropy efforts. She then introduced Dr. Alta Boover, Assistant Professor of Music; Josh Young, Assistant Professor of Theatre; and Lois Kaare, Special Lecturer in Music who performed, "Anything You Can Do" by Irvin Berlin from "Annie Get your Gun" and a "West Side Story Medley" by Leonard Bernstein from the musical "West Side Story."

Trustee Muchmore, seconded by Trustee Schostak, moved approval of the Consent Agenda and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

Prior to the approval of the Consent Agenda, Trustee Allen requested that the University Personnel Actions be removed from the Consent Agenda to discuss progress being made to have a more diverse faculty in the School of Medicine. Provost Lentini noted that the specific issue to be addressed in the exit report from the LCME was with the Chairs at Beaumont. OUWB Interim Dean Mezwa added that these concerns were raised in a preliminary report and that the final report will be received at the end of February or early March and he confirmed that an area of concern raised by the LCME was the diversity of the Chairs and the selection of the Chairs. Of the 15 Chairs, there is one female and one African American. This is not just an OUWB issue, but exists across the country. They have adopted a diversity liaison program within the Medical School that ensures that in every search there will be somebody who's trained in diversity that sits on the search team to make sure that not only is the committee itself diverse, but so is the population of candidates. He noted that a more diverse body of Chairs is not going to happen overnight because they are not removing sitting Chairs, but any search and any hiring will have diversity addressed from this point forward.

After discussion, Trustee Allen, seconded by Trustee DeVore, moved approval of the University Personnel Actions and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

# <u>Schematic Design Approval for Project S.U.C.C.E.S.S. and Authorization to Complete</u>

Mr. Scott G. Kunselman, Chief Operating Officer, presented the Schematic Design Approval for Project S.U.C.C.E.S.S. and Authorization to Complete recommendation as set forth in the agendum item.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees approves the Schematic Design of the Project S.U.C.C.E.S.S. (Attachment A, as may be immaterially amended during continuing design and construction phases of the project); and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the President, the Chief Operating Officer, and their respective designees, to perform all acts and deeds and to execute and deliver all contracts, instruments and documents required by this resolution that are necessary, expedient and proper in connection with the Project S.U.C.C.E.S.S. project and the ongoing administration of the Project; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that said contracts, instruments and documents shall be reviewed by and be in a form acceptable to the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations and conform to the legal standards of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.

Mr. Kunselman began, noting that in February of this year, the Board approved a budget of \$20.5 million for Project S.U.C.C.E.S.S., which includes one major construction project, the expansion of Wilson Hall, as well as several areas of renovation across campus. The primary goal of the Project is to improve and expand key student facing services, while also improving the co-location of several departments. Key partners have already been selected to execute this Project and are now ready to seek schematic approval. Albert Kahn is the architectural and engineering partner and Rockford is the construction manager chosen for this Project.

Stephen White and Andrew Stone from Albert Kahn & Associates provided an overview of the schematic design process, including interviewing over 29 various groups across campus. The Wilson Hall project will be a four-story expansion, with the first two levels student focused to support enhanced services and the top two levels of the expansion are to co-locate the Cabinet members from across campus. It will be a 40,000 square foot facility off the northeast corner of Wilson Hall, utilizing P-2 as it sits today and paralleling P2 to take advantage of the very unique topography to allow for easy student access. They presented a slide presentation showing the schematic design and answered questions from the Board about the layout of the building, available conference rooms, the technological capability and upgradability in the building addition, and whether the expansion would be

LEED certified. Mr. White indicated that although they are not tracking for a LEED certification, the baseline for all our decisions being made typically is considered a LEED silver level to optimize energy efficiencies.

After discussion, Trustee Allen, seconded by Trustee Schostak, moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.
