

Grizz Facts: A look at net price of attendance

Students who receive grants and scholarships from federal, state and local governments, as well as from the University, see their actual college costs lowered. Net price is the cost of attendance* after subtracting the amount of grants and scholarships a student receives. More than 2,000 Oakland University full-time freshmen received grant and scholarship aid in 2017. The effect was that OU's net price for in-state freshmen was lower than most other public universities in Michigan.
