



Neville Marriner Meadow Brook Artistic Director



The artistic vision of Neville Marriner has shaped the direction of the Music Festival's classical symphony programs the past five years. His keen sensitivity for balance and proportion has been vital to Meadow Brook presenting distinguished programs and appearances by world-class musicians.

The scope of Neville Marriner's leadership has been far reaching. Representative musical styles from the 18th through 20th centuries that embrace European, Japanese, and American composers; symphonic, choral, and concert opera masterpieces; solo works for string, keyboard, and wind instruments as well as for voice; a roster of outstanding guest conductors and soloists from around the world; appearances by two major American symphony orchestras in addition to the Detroit Symphony Orchestra; portray some of the major contri-

butions Neville Marriner has made to over 80 classical programs at Meadow Brook since 1979.

The attention to detail that Neville Marriner has paid to exploring different approaches to Meadow Brook's classical music experience has offered variety to the broad interests of Festival audiences. His zest for the spontaneity of music-making extended across the footlights on the occasions he conducted performances. Over 175,000 Music Festival concertgoers have been direct beneficiaries of the musical richness of one of the world's front-rank conductors.

We are grateful for the contributions of Maestro Marriner. His sharing and caring as Artistic Director of the Music Festival has brought new dimensions to the Meadow Brook experience.

Detroit Symphony Orchestra

The 1983-84 season marks the seventieth anniversary of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra. During the past seventy years it has become firmly established among the foremost musical organizations of the world and has won the highest critical acclaim wherever it has appeared.

Each season the Orchestra presents more than 200 concerts, including more than 80 regular subscription concerts and a number of special concerts in its home, the Henry and Edsel Ford Auditorium. Series of Young People's Concerts and school concerts are also given annually both at Ford Auditorium and in Detroit area schools. Outstate tour concerts, such as the annual Upper Peninsula Summer Festival, permit citizens throughout the state of Michigan to hear the DSO. Free concerts are also offered each summer at various metropolitan Detroit sites.

Meadow Brook Music Festival at Oakland University, north of Detroit, is the site of the Orchestra's summer home. It is recognized as one of the major summer music festivals in the nation.

The Orchestra conducts its activities in several areas. In 1978 the DSO's nine-program Beethoven Festival was telecast nationally on PBS, bringing the Orchestra into millions of American homes. After an absence of almost two decades from contract recording, the DSO returned to that field with a major international label, London Records, and the first three albums were recorded in Detroit in the spring of 1978. The first disc, an all-Tchaikovsky special featuring the 1812 Overture was released in January of 1979 and is still a top-selling classical album in the U.S. It was followed by the release of eight Dorati/Detroit Symphony discs.

A series of annual mid-season festivals was established in 1977. The initial offering profiled the life and works of Beethoven and included performances of all nine symphonies. The next season's "Schubert and Vienna" Festival generated much national and international attention, and was highlighted by the U.S. premier of Schubert's opera Alfonso und Estrella. For the third mid-season festival, in April 1980, Detroit was the site of North America's most comprehensive series of events ever devoted to Johannes Brahms. Highlights of that festival included 64 guest artists in 19 musical events, the International Brahms Congress with musicologists from around the world, and the first public exhibition of the largest privately-held collection of Brahmsiana in Europe. The next mid-season festival, in March 1981, was a centennial celebration honoring Bela Bartok.

The Orchestra first performed in Europe in October and November 1979. The tour consisted of 24 concerts in eight countries: Spain, West Germany, Belgium, France, England, Sweden, Norway, and Switzerland. A dramatically successful tour in major music capitals such as London, Paris and Berlin, produced rave reviews, standing ovations, and numerous encores. Eurotour '79 placed the DSO in the international spotlight as one of the world's top ranked orchestras.

Antal Dorati holds the post of Conductor Laureate. Max Rudolf serves as consultant on artistic matters.

MEADOW BROOK HALL at OAKLAND UNIVERSITY A National Treasure



In all ages, humanity has carved its soul into the clay and stone and pigment of its monuments. Through these forms we relive the heritage of time and read the dreams of other years. Through art and artifacts we experience history's immutable truths. Meadow Brook Hall stands as a monument to an era that is gone forever. Untethered and flamboyant, that era gathered all the finest riches of the world as baubles for its celebration of exuberance. That time is past. With it went a wealth of skills and craftsmanship; little remains to show they ever existed. Meadow Brook Hall embodies a history of that time. So long as Meadow Brook Hall remains, the legacy will live.

Meadow Brook Hall is an American dream, out of an age of extravagant hopes that often became realities.

It began with Matilda Rausch, a young Canadian farm girl who moved to Michigan and met John Dodge, a mechanical genius from the little town of Niles, Michigan. Dodge had begun to make automotive history when the two married in 1907. The automotive era came of age, and when Dodge died at 55, he left a family, a fortune and the beginnings of Matilda's mansion. That home was never


finished, but in time the young widow remarried. With Alfred Wilson, she began again to make her long-held dream come true.

Meadow Brook Hall was completed in 1929 at the cost of \$4,000,000, one of the finest examples of residential architecture anywhere in the world. Its craftsmanship, household appointments and art treasures are now priceless and irreplaceable.

Matilda Dodge Wilson left her entire estate to the State of Michigan. This

bequest became the foundation for Oakland University, and the people of Michigan became beneficiaries of Matilda's dream—one of the most unique cultural treasures and munificent gifts to public education by a private donor in the history of the state and possibly the nation.



THE KRESGE FOUNDATION

The Meadow Brook Music Festival expresses its appreciation to one of its most important benefactors — The Kresge Foundation.

In 1964 when the Festival was a dream, the Kresge Foundation made a \$76,000 gift to the capital fund in memory of civic leader and foundation trustee, Howard C. Baldwin, for whom the pavilion is named. A second gift a year later of \$50,000 made possible the permanent seating in the pavilion.
