Three Oakland University professors from the School of Engineering and Computer Science received grants to continue their research in different areas.

Professor Gautam B. Singh has received an award from DaimlerChrysler for "Decision Support System for Ergonomics Evaluations." This award is for \$99,308.

Professor Naim Kheir has received an award from the Department of Energy – Argonne National Laboratory for "Energy Management and Control Strategies for Parallel Hybrid Vehicles: Phase 2." This award is for \$75,000.

Professor Viviana Sandor has received an award from the University Research Committee for "Wavelet-Based Image Computing." This award is for \$1,000.
