APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Susan Awbrey moved to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2018, Graduate Council Meeting as written. Meir Shillor seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Stacking Certificates

Council invited Dr. Nivedita Mukherji, Associate Dean of the School of Business to discuss the School of Business proposal of stacking certificates. Dr. Mukherji discussed the national trend for a decrease in MBA enrollment. OU at this time has not seen a significant decrease, but this could become an issue in the future. School of Business is looking for opportunities to increase or maintain retention. The certificates would be at the post-bachelor level. The certificates would be five courses in length and in Finance, Business Essentials and Business Analytics. Individuals who complete the certificate could enroll in MBA program with a reduction in credits. Students would be required to complete all MBA core requirements. However, 15 credits could be in electives, such as marketing. This certificate stacking is designed for students with prior work experience in the field.

Current trends at OU indicated that half the students interested in certificate programs already have a background in business, while the other half are from other fields, such as Engineering without a business background. The certificates are to attract those already working in the field. The thought is that many Companies are willing to assist their employees with certifications. Once a student has the certificate, they may be more inclined to enroll in the MBA program to further their education.

B. Masters of Arts in Biology Modification

Meir Shillor moved to approve the Masters of Arts in Biology Modification. Zissimos Mourelatos seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Applied & Computational Physics

Council in receipt of program modification form. This program was previously approved by the Senate. Susan Awbrey to contact department for clarification on what is being modified, decrease from 90 credits to 80, and if so what courses are being dropped.

D. <u>ISE (Industrial & Systems Engineering) Change University's Definition of a Full-Time Graduate Student from 8 credits per Semester to 7 Credits per Semester</u>

Zissimos Mourelatos and Meghan Harris assigned to review.

E. School of Nursing - Adult/Gerontological Acute Care Nurse Practitioner (AGACNP)

Kris Thompson and Meir Shillor assigned to review.

F. <u>Discussion regarding moving a 3 credit to 4 credit base for OU</u>

Council briefly discussed OU moving to a 3 credit to 4 credit base. This is currently being discussed at the Undergraduate level and would move OU in line with other Michigan based Universities. This will be further discussed at a future Graduate Council Meeting.
