Working In The Arts: Technology In Music Education

A decade or more ago, OU had a class about the use of classroom technology in music education, but now, reflecting the way much professional music is produced, **Associate Professor of Music Deborah VanderLinde** says that technology is infused throughout almost every course in OU's music education degree. Both she and **Associate Professor Joe Shively** have incorporated the most up-to-date technology in student projects. In the class Teaching Music in the Twenty-First Century II, all projects are digital.

Dakotah Cooper (BM '10 and MEd '14) teaches general music at Carpenter and Webber Elementary Schools in the Lake Orion School District. His students still learn using many traditional classroom activities, but he also has them compose and arrange music with iPads, GarageBand and Logic. "It really comes down to teaching students what tools they have at their disposal," he said, "and helping them choose what fits best." He credits OU with giving him a strong philosophical base that helps him adapt his teaching to the needs of his students.
