Master of Science in Information Technology Program Modification Proposal

Reviewers: Karl Mejeske and Kris ThompsonFirst Reading: Debatable, amendable, but not eligible for final vote at this meeting.Motion: To approve the Master of Science in Information Technology Program ModificationProposal.

Reviewers were concerned that there is potential for confusion between the name of the program, Master of Science in Information Technology, with the School of Business' Master of Science in Information Technology Management program. It was suggested that adding Engineering to the program name would resolve any potential confusion. Dr. Roth suggested that Dr. Majeske forward an email to the Dean of Graduate Education addressing the concern. Dr. Petrescu can then recommend of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering to consider modifying the program name or provide a justification as to why they would prefer to leave the name as originally proposed.

<u>Proposed Policy—Institutional Records of Graduate Student Complaints</u>. Members discussed that the verbiage of the policy is not clear in regard to what written complaints from students would be recorded by Graduate Study and Lifelong Learning. Members would like clarification on if Graduate Study would only record written complaints that are submitted directly to Graduate Study, or would written complaints submitted to and recorded by the departments then be forwarded to the Graduate Study office to be recorded.

For more clarification as to what is required by federal law, Claire Rammel stated that she will post the federal requirements on eSpace.

Appointment to University Research Committee (URC). A recommendation for an appointment to replace Judith Fouladbakhsh on the URC is needed due to her resignation at the end of the Winter 2016 semester to work on a NIH grant. Dr. Roth suggested that, since Dr. Fouladbakhsh is from the School of Nursing, her replacement should be someone from the School of Nursing. Margaret Glembocki said that she would inquire within the School of Nursing about a replacement and report back.
