Professor Michelle Piskulich conducted the survey during the daylong orientation for all student athletes on September 4, 2001. The results of this analysis were available on October 15. Based on these results, we wrote a letter to the Vice President for Student Affairs prior to her renegotiations of the food service contract articulating our concerns. In addition, the chair of this committee met irregularly with the Student Athletic Advisory Committee. This year the focus of this group
