Sigma Pi Pig Roast offers fun for all

Oakland University students, faculty and staff are invited to the largest nonalcoholic event on any university campus in Michigan on Friday, Sept. 6, from 7 p.m. to 1 a.m.

The eighth annual Sigma Pi Pig Roast, to be held on the upper playing fields across from the new student apartments, is a free event.

Sigma Pi is providing six pigs to roast, which should yield about 900 pounds of pork. There also will be free beverages and snow cones, a dunk tank, an inflatable obstacle course and other games, and a deejay. Not leaving anyone out, Sigma Pi will provide garden burgers and a vegetable tray for vegetarians.

"OU students, faculty and staff also may bring two guests who are over 18 who present a photo ID," said Al Zurawskyj, a sophomore political science major and Sigma Pi special events chairman. "Last year, we had about 1,250 people at the roast. But this year, with the expected increase in enrollment and the new student apartments, we're expecting more than 1,500 people.

"We want to schedule this event to coincide with other Welcome Week activities and invite everyone to come out and have a good time. We also want to stress that the event is completely nonalcoholic and anyone who tries to skirt this policy will not be tolerated."

Sigma Pi is one of four OU fraternities that belong to the **North American Interfraternity Conference**, which is a federation of 66 national and international fraternities that focus on developing the human spirit.
