## OnTime to be offline for two days

The **OnTime system** will be offline two days for system maintenance beginning Tuesday, Dec. 17, at 8 a.m. The system will be available again at 8 a.m. Thursday, Dec. 19.

OnTime tracks appointments and meeting rooms for faculty and staff throughout Oakland University's campus.

"The system is bogged down with old records. It's unwieldy to open and takes longer that it needs to," said Steve Glowacki, senior systems analyst. "After the maintenance, users may notice an improvement in response time. It will definitely improve performance for system administration."

Glowacki estimates there are one million records in the system. All records prior to Dec 1, 2001, will be removed. Users are encouraged to print copies of any information they wish to keep for their files as well as any meeting information pertaining to Dec. 17 or 18.
