My name is Tabor (they/them), and I'm a Research Assistant to Dr. Sabra Katz-Wise at Boston Children's Hospital. We are looking for gender minority (i.e., non-cisgender) (GM) young adults (age 18-25 years) to be part of a community advisory board (CAB) to serve an advisory role to our study examining mental health, substance use, and discrimination among binary and non-binary gender minority young adults. Since few studies have considered these specific topics, this is an opportunity to directly shape the world's understanding of how to best serve this community's needs.

As part of our commitment to liberatory work, we aim to center the perspectives of GM folks with more than one marginalized identity. To this end, trans femme folks/folks who experience transmisogyny, BIPOC folks, and non-heterosexual folks are especially encouraged to apply.

Members of the CAB will participate in quarterly 2-hour virtual meetings over the course of our 2 year project (4-5 meetings total). CAB members will receive \$150 for each meeting. The length of membership in the GM CAB will be November 2021 – March 2023. Our first meeting will happen in early November 2021, specific date pending member availability.
