#### SEHS CC and ABA Clinic Participate in OU's Day of Service

On November 16, the SEHS Counseling Center (SEHS CC) partnered with the ABA Clinic to participate in the OU Day of Service. The OU Day of Service is an opportunity for students to participate in various volunteer projects as a way of giving back to the community. The SEHS CC and ABA clinic worked on sensory



packets for the "Look. Uncover. Nurture. Act" (LUNA) project at Easter Seals, which helps to understand the impact of trauma on a child's functioning and to provide assessments. The packets, which included silly putty, feathers, stress balls, a picture frame for a picture of a safe person and cards with inspirational quotes provide comfort for the children during their assessments. Staff from the SEHS CC and ABA Clinic were able to complete 77 packets for Easter Seals.
