

In this study, Ji-Eun collaborated with a group of Korean and American mathematics teacher educators to examine the similarities and differences between U.S. and Korean elementary preservice teacher's views of equity as reflected in mathematics lesson planning.

"Genius of George Wright" Published by OU SEHS Graduate

After four years of research and writing, the definitive biography of legendary theatre organist and recording star George Wright has been published by the Coale Education Group, Inc., under the title "The Genius of George Wright." The author, William L. Coale, Ph.D., received his doctorate in Educational Leadership from Oakland University in 2005. He retired from his position as superintendent of schools to California in 2009, spent a year writing op-ed pieces for major Michigan newspapers on the topic of education reform, then turned his efforts toward this challenging book project. Research took him to the Performing Arts Library at Lincoln Center, the Margaret Herrick (Oscars) Library in Hollywood, the American Organ Institute Archives and Library (AOIAL) at the University of Oklahoma, and numerous other public libraries across California.



The 600-page biography is lavishly illustrated with photographs, documents, concert programs, newspaper and magazine articles, as well as a large amount of Wright's personal ephemera acquired by the author during his acquisition of BANDA, the recording company that released some two dozen of George Wright CDs. Additionally, Bill conducted 36 personal interviews of individuals closely associated with Wright. The books and CDs are available for purchase at GeniusOfGeorgeWright.com
