Evening in the ERL: Spotting the Warning Signs Event – February 6

An Evening in the ERL — Spotting the Warning Signs: Supporting Children Facing Trauma and Stress in Our Classrooms will be held on Wednesday, February 6 from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m.

Statistics about the number of children who have experienced at least one adverse childhood experience (ACE) are alarming. A 2017 fact sheet on [adverse experiences among U.S. children](#), issued by the Childhood and Adolescent Health Measurement Initiative, found that nearly 47% of all children in the United States have experienced ACEs such as abuse, neglect, death of a parent/guardian or witnessing community violence. A panel of OU faculty and staff, along with social workers and educators from Rochester Schools, will present information and a discussion about identifying and responding to the needs of children in K–12 classrooms who are living with stress or have faced traumatic experiences, which impact learning and behavior.

All students, faculty and staff are welcome, but registration will cap at 40, so please [register for the event promptly](#).
