Using Novelist Plus

Looking for some great books? Not sure what to read next? Need a fun title to read aloud to your children? Check out Novelist Plus — free to all residents of Michigan, courtesy of the [Michigan eLibrary \(MeL\)](#).

There is a direct link to Novelist on the [ERL home page](#) as one of our [External Book Review Databases](#). Find just the right book by subject, age, genre, awards won, read-alikes and much more. You can read reviews and learn about the author, and find tools



for teachers such as Lexile levels and Common Core standards.

For a quick list of diverse and recommended titles, try browsing their “Grab and Go Book Lists.” (You can access this from the “Quick Links” menu in the Novelist toolbar.) These curriculum-based lists focus specifically on the topics that students, teachers and librarians have asked for. Many of the included titles have been considered the “best of the best” by librarians, teachers and literature specialists. The menu to the left allows you to limit results by age and interest level, publication date, subject and even “read aloud.”
