Staying Healthy During the COVID-19 Outbreak

Earlier this week, campus administrators announced that OU will suspend face-to-face classes through the end of the semester in response to the rise in COVID-19 cases that have been confirmed in the state of Michigan. The university has recommended all students, staff and faculty actively self-monitor for [symptoms](#) related to COVID-19. Here are a few tips to help keep you and your loved ones safe and healthy:


