New Tool: Mapping Medicare Disparities

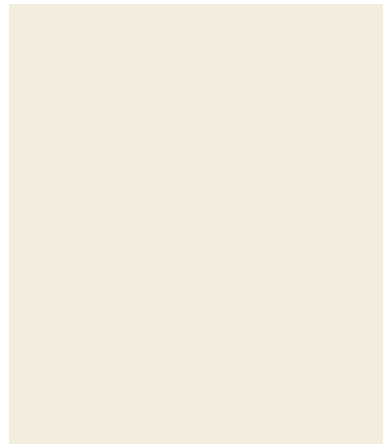

(CMS) recently released a new data tool, the **Mapping Medicare Disparities (MMD) Tool**, to aid in measuring and comparing health outcomes data for 18 different chronic conditions.

Specific data points include: disease prevalence, costs, hospitalization, emergency department utilization, readmissions rates, and mortality. The tool currently covers data from 2012 - 2014 and can be narrowed by county or state.
