Evening College--The Evening College proposal prepared by the ad hoc committee for the EPC was accepted.

Trimester--Messrs. O'Dowd and Stoutenburg reported on the University of Pittsburgh's "Year-Around School Conference".

Cheating--Members of the student body have become concerned about the cheating that is taking place at MSUO. The members of the Administrative Group felt that the faculty should be re-alerted to this problem and that the University should put the institutional policies on this matter in writing so all students can read them as well as hear them.

Math-Science Conference--A proposal has been sent to the National Science Foundation to hold a conference in September at Meadowbrook Hall to discuss a math-science course for non-science majors.

Peace Corps.--Mr. Wilder asked what MSUO's attitude would be toward making the University an indoctrination center. Mr. Varner will invite Tom Quimby to talk with the students about the program.

Council on Library Resources--The Ford Foundation is working with the Council on Library Resources in the preparation of an annotated bibliography which will serve as a buying guide for small colleges. Mr. Wilder asked if MSUO would be interested in furnishing space to house the project. Mr. Varner indicated that MSUO would look with favor on the idea.

Engineering Science Course--Mr. McKay announced that an Engineering course is needed in the spring quarter for about a dozen students. Mr. Varner asked Messrs. McKay, Hammerle, and Tomboulian to take the necessary step to meet the need.
