## LEADERSHIP CHANGES IN PROFESSIONAL THEATRE, ACTING ACADEMY

Chancellor O'Dowd has announced the appointment of Terence Kilburn as acting director of the Academy of Dramatic Art and acting artistic director of the Meadow Brook Theatre. He succeeds John Fernald, who tendered his resignation last week to accept a post at the State University of New York at Buffalo. Fernald established the professional theatre here in 1967 and later that same year launched the ADA on the pattern of the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art in London, which he headed for 10 years.

Kilburn, an ADA faculty member since last fall, directed several of the ADA Studio Company plays and also directed two Meadow Brook Theatre offerings, "Summer and Smoke" and "Ah, Wilderness!" He was a founder of the Players Ring Theatre in Los Angeles and a frequent director of the Theatre Group in the same city. As a young actor he played leading roles in many Hollywood films, notably "A Christmas Carol" and "Goodbye, Mr. Chips."
