Subject: Annual Report for UCUI for 1979-1980

The UCUI met on several occasions in the 1979-80 year and handled some routine program changes. The anticipated major issues of:

- a. General Education revision, and
- b. A standard three-credit course did not materialize during the 1979-80 committee season. The General Education proposal is still in the hands of the General Education Commission. The "Flexible Scheduling Committee" agreed to drop the issue of a standard three-credit course at Oakland University.

At least two issues were not resolved during 1979-80. The first issue is the Entry-Year Commission report's recommendation of an "entry-year course." The second unresolved issue is the setting of a standard university policy on what catalog a returning student (readmitted student) should use.


The decisions we did reach during the 1979-80 season were:
