David Daniels: A Life In Music

All around the world there are conductors, musicians and musicologists who have the same essential reference book on their shelves. *Orchestral Music: A Handbook* is a nuts and bolts guide to the standard repertoire for American orchestra. It lists the duration of each piece, the required instrumentation and the publishers, all assembled and indexed by Oakland University Professor Emeritus **David Daniels**, who confesses to a "personality quirk" which leaves him always wanting to "get something just right." When he first began conducting regularly, all Daniels had was a list of timings which had been typed for him by his wife Jimmie Sue. It was a copy of a note book loaned to him by **James Dixon**, his mentor at the University of Iowa. Daniels said, "In those days it was not easy to get timings. It wasn't until the CD revolution that timings began to be provided with recordings." [Read more.](#)
