## Charter class to reunite in October

Cost is \$100 per person, and advance reservations are required. The suggested attire is evening cocktail. This is not a black tie event.

Join campus representatives and OU's own musical group Meadow Brook Estate for brunch in the Oakland Center Ballroom to commemorate the event and wish classmates well as the reunion weekend concludes. Cost is \$25 per person and includes a full buffet lunch. Advance reservations are required.
- 2 p.m. – OU Women's Soccer Game  
Watch the Golden Grizzlies as they take on Cincinnati at the Lower Athletic Fields located east of the Recreation Center. Admission is free.
