"Students can also drop off their completed application forms for an immediate admissions decision," said Assistant Director of Admissions Megan McNally. "If students bring transcripts from each college attended and a self-addressed stamped envelope, a credit evaluation will be mailed back to them."

Students also will learn about OU's educational programs, including: the **College of Arts and Sciences**, **School of Business Administration**, **School of Education and Human Services**, **School of Nursing**, and **Bachelor of General Studies**. Students in attendance will get a good overall view of what OU has to offer. They can talk to representatives from many departments and services, ask questions, and pick up literature. Refreshments also will be served.
