OU hosting post-election panel discussion

Oakland University is hosting a special post-election panel discussion, titled "Decision 2004: The Campaign Roundup," which will focus on what happened, why it happened, and what it means for the future of public policy and government in the United States. The discussion is Friday, Nov. 19, from noon to 2 p.m. in the Oakland Center Banquet Rooms.

"We hope that the campaign roundup will engage students, faculty and members of the community in a dialogue about the campaign that just ended as well as what lies ahead," said David Dulio, assistant professor of political science and organizer of this event. "It's important for us to go back and revisit the main aspects of campaign 2004 to see how we performed as a democracy and to look forward to what this means for the next four years. After all, the hard work starts now for the president. He now has to turn to the real problems the country faces."

The panelists include Chuck Stokes from WXYZ Channel 7 News, Mark Hornbeck from The Detroit News, Ed Sarpolus of EPIC/MRA – a leading survey research firm in Michigan, and Rich Robinson from the Michigan Campaign Finance Network.
