OU professor to appear on the History Channel

Oakland University history professor Geoffrey Wawro will appear on an upcoming History Channel special about a German U-boat during World War II.

The special, "U-571: History or Hollywood," will coincide with the release of "U-571," a new movie from Universal Pictures studio. The film will open on April 21. The History Channel's special program will air at 9 p.m. Saturday, April 22. Prof. Wawro appears on the program as an expert on naval warfare.
