OU announces Hildum scholarship winners

Oakland University's **Department of Rhetoric, Communication and Journalism** recently announced the 2004 Donald C. Hildum Endowed Scholarship in Communication winners.

The eight winners are Amber Allred of Fenton, Tara Finn of Sterling Heights, Elizabeth Gregory of Detroit, Delinda Long of Rochester, Caitlyn Palmer of Lake Orion, Paul Ventura of Clinton Township, Theresa Vitale of Macomb, and Rebecca Williams of West Bloomfield.

The \$2,900 scholarship is given in varying amounts to students based on their commitment to strengthening community within the university and the broader society. Other considerations include academic promise and financial need.

The scholarship was established in honor of Donald C. Hildum, the founding member and former chair of the Department of Communication, and his wife, Priscilla, a longtime Oakland University administrator. Since Hildum's passing in 1996, faculty, administrators, alumni, and friends and family of Hildum have supported the scholarship fund.
