Yale professor to lecture at OU

Oakland University's **Department of Psychology** will host Alan Kazdin, the John M. Musser professor of Psychology at Yale University.

Kazdin will present a lecture titled, "The Diagnosis, Assessment and Treatment of Aggressive and Antisocial Behavior," on Thursday, Oct. 25, at 1 p.m. in the Oakland Center Gold Rooms.

The lecture is part of a donation given to the **Department of Psychology** to sponsor a distinguished lecture on child psychology, with an emphasis on child behavioral disorders.

Kazdin has served as the editor of "Behavior Therapy, the Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology, Psychological Assessment," and is the current editor of "Current Directions in Psychological Science." He has authored numerous scholarly articles and his published books include, "Single-case Research Designs: Methods for clinical and applied settings (1982)," "Child psychotherapy: Developing and identifying effective treatments (1988)," "Psychotherapy for children and adolescents: Directions for research and practice (2000)." He is the editor of the eight-volume Encyclopedia of Psychology (2000).
