Seminar to help prevent workplace violence

Oakland University's **School of Education and Human Services (SEHS)** is offering "Managing Risk in Your Organization: Practical Approaches for Preventing Workplace Violence." The workshop will take place on the following Saturdays: Jan. 19 and 26 and Feb. 2 and 9 from 9 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. The deadline to register is Monday, Jan. 7.

The focus of the workshop is to increase awareness, help organizations recognize red flags, assess threats, respond to critical incidents and recover from the traumatic consequences of workplace violence. Participants also will learn how to develop a violence-prevention and response plan.

Judy L. Jacobs, a national consultant and lecturer with more than 25 years of experience in employee education, risk management and instructional program design, will lead the course. She has presented numerous classes on workplace violence in various industries. Jacobs co-authored "The Workplace Violence in Healthcare Tool Kit: A Guide to Establishing a Prevention and Training Program," published by McGraw-Hill.

The cost of the workshop is \$295, if enrolled for continuing education units (CEUs). Participants have the option to take the course for two university undergraduate or graduate credits.
