Adult piano classes being offered

The **Department of Music, Theater and Dance** is pleased to announce the offering of a non-credit, community adult piano class and private piano lessons for students of all ages during the winter 2002 semester.

The adult class will meet once a week on Tuesdays, Jan. 15 until April 9, from 7 to 8 p.m. in the new Clavinova piano lab in Varner Hall. The class is geared toward beginners, but may be a nice refresher course for adults who studied the piano as children and would like to regain some of those lost skills. The cost of the class is \$150.

Private lessons will be arranged based on the availability of both the student and teacher. The cost of private lessons is \$180 for the semester, beginning the week of Jan. 14 and ending the week of April 8.
