## Student award nominations due Feb. 15

Members of the Oakland University community can nominate candidates for the Alfred G. and Matilda R. Wilson Award and the Human Relations Award. All nominations are due Friday, Feb. 15, in the **Dean of Students Office**, 144 Oakland Center.

"One of the most enjoyable aspects of university work is the recognition of student leadership and achievement," said Karen Lloyd, assistant dean of students. "I am asking for your assistance as we attempt to identify candidates for Oakland's most prestigious university awards."

**Alfred G. and Matilda R. Wilson Awards** are presented annually to Oakland University students who have contributed as scholars, leaders and responsible citizens. Nominees must be seniors who have maintained a strong academic record, usually a 3.3 GPA or higher, and have demonstrated leadership qualities and responsible citizenship. Students who have completed their academic work in June, August or December 2001, and those students who will complete their academic work by April 2002, are eligible for nomination. The winners are presented with an individual plaque and financial award of \$500. Their names also are added to a bronze plaque located on campus.

The **Human Relations Award** is presented annually to Oakland University seniors who have contributed to greater racial understanding on campus and have worked at various levels for the improvement of a positive racial climate. Nominees must have completed their academic work in June, August, or December 2001, or will complete it by April 2002. In addition, students must be in good academic standing and have demonstrated both responsible citizenship and leadership, especially in the area of racial understanding. The recipient of the award will receive a certificate and a stipend in the amount of \$500.
