Tea on Tuesdays continues in 2002

Tea on Tuesdays at **Meadow Brook Hall** is continuing in 2002. On the third Tuesday each month from 3 to 4:30 p.m., Oakland University's Meadow Brook Hall will offer tea to the public in the Christopher Wren Dining Room and outside on the Loggia Terrace during the summer months.

The Tea on Tuesdays program includes a short presentation on the history of taking tea and features objects from Meadow Brook Hall's collections, including silver and porcelain tea services. The menu includes assorted tea sandwiches, scones, quiche and more.

Whether catching up with friends and family or visiting with business associates, this tradition provides a midday break in one of the country's most beautiful and historically significant settings.

Meadow Brook Hall is the fourth largest historic house museum in the United States. It is especially renowned for its superb craftsmanship, architectural detailing and grand scale.

Built in the 1920s as the residence of Oakland University founders, Matilda Dodge Wilson (widow of auto baron John Dodge) and her second husband Alfred G. Wilson, the 80,000-square-foot, Tudor-revival-style mansion is complete with collections of original art and furnishings.

Listed on both the national and state registers of historic places, **Meadow Brook Hall** strives to preserve and interpret its architecture, landscape, and fine and decorative art so visitors may be entertained, educated and inspired by its history.

Cost for Tea on Tuesdays is \$30 per person. Prepaid reservations are required.
