## OU professor hosts show on The History Channel

Oakland University Professor of History, Geoffrey Wawro, will host "Hardcover History" on The History Channel. The show airs Sunday, November 19, at 10 a.m. and discusses books written about events in history.

Last April, Wawro appeared as an expert guest on The History Channel's U-571: History or Hollywood, a documentary about a German U-boat during World War II.
