Meir Shillor's career accomplishments include the publication of over 90 scholarly publications and is an internationally recognized authority in the area of contact mechanics. Shillor, professor of mathematical statistics, has spearheaded the development of this interdisciplinary field, which involves using theory, simulation, and modeling to understand the behavior of physical systems.

Shillor's work is useful in such applications as friction, wear and erosion. The global scope of his work is evident in the list of countries where he has taught and lectured, including, Great Britain, Canada, China, Croatia, France, Israel, Portugal, Sweden, Poland and Switzerland.
