Sherri Oden, associate professor of human development and child studies, has been principal investigator of many major studies. One of these studies was published recently as a book titled "Into Adulthood: A study of the effects of Head Start" (Oden, S., Schweinhart, L.S., Weikart, D.P., with Marcus, S.M. and Xie, Y., 2000).

Oden also was co-investigator of the High/Scope Head Start Quality Research Center, one of four national research centers working in collaboration with the Head Start Bureau, U.S. Administration for Children and Families.

Oden has co-authored two previous books and many articles and chapters in numerous child and youth development journals and books. She has made many research presentations at national conferences and served on national research panels. Most recently, Oden co-edited a research monograph, "Early Childhood Settings in 15 Countries: What are Their Structural Characteristics? The IEA Preprimary Project, Phase 2" (Olmsted, P. O. and Montie, J., with Claxton, J., and Oden, S., Eds., 2001).
