Nancy Joseph is a teacher of teachers. As an adviser for the Secondary Teacher Education Program, a cooperative program between the College of Arts and Sciences and School of Education and Human Services, Joseph is responsible for the training and professional development of future English teachers in secondary schools.

During the past academic year, Joseph published six articles and notes on teaching practices, including “Metacognition in the Classroom: Examining Theory and Practice,” which was featured in the prestigious journal “Pedagogy.” She also was awarded an Oakland University Faculty Research Fellowship for her proposal, “Exploring Academic Literacy: Teaching Secondary Students to Develop Metacognitive Functioning in Their Reading and Writing.”
