University Research Committee Annual Report 1996-97

Dear Colleagues:

This annual report includes a financial summary and itemized description of projects funded by or through the University Research Committee during the 1996-97 operating cycle. As this report indicates, the majority of the Committee's time was spent on the distribution of contract research funds. The Committee spent \$146,824, the entire amount of contractual funds available, to support faculty research projects. In addition, \$7,473 in supplemental funding was awarded for student research grants and other research related activities; this supplemental funding was provided by the Office of the President.

The second year of the President's Colloquium Series was broken down into two programs, one during Fall semester and one during Winter semester. The two speakers were **Beverly Berger**, Department of Physics, and **Robert Goldstein**, Department of Political Science. Each colloquium featured a program on the individual faculty member's research. We are pleased that continued support is being provided for this important series.

We are also grateful for Dr. Russi's commitment of continued support for the **New Investigator Research Excellence Award** competition. This award provides a mechanism for the university community to recognize and appreciate the accomplishments of junior faculty, along with faculty members who have many more years of research experience.
