

## **Rogers Record of Bipartisanship in the 112th Congress**

**Authored or co-authored 13 bipartisan bills  
8 passed the House  
6 signed into law**

**[LAW]** **H.R. 754, Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2011.** *Authorized funding for national security and intelligence programs in 2011.*

- *Passed the House on a bipartisan 392-15 vote*
- *Passed the Senate by voice vote*
- *Signed into law by President Obama*

**[LAW]** **H.R. 892, Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012.** *Authorized funding for national security and intelligence programs in 2012.*

- *Passed the House on a bipartisan 396-23 vote*
- *Passed the Senate by voice vote*
- *Signed into law by President Obama*

**[LAW]** **H.R. 3975, legislation to reauthorize the Pediatric Medical Device Safety and Improvement Act.** *Reauthorizes Rogers' 2007 law to improve access to breakthrough medical devices for pediatric populations.*

- *Introduced with Rep. Ed Markey, Democrat from Massachusetts*
- *Signed into law by President Obama*

**[LAW]** **H.R. 4274, BPCA and PREA Reauthorization Act.** *Reauthorizes 2 successful pediatric drug laws which make it easier and safer to test and prescribe prescription drugs for children.*

- *Introduced with Rep. Anna Eshoo, Democrat from California*
- *Signed into law by President Obama*

**[LAW]** **H.R. 1497, legislation to repatriate remains of U.S. sailors buried in Tripoli, Libya.**

- *Passed by voice vote in House*
- *Similar version passed by voice vote in Senate, signed into law by President Obama*

**[LAW]** **H.R. 596, Private Investment in Commuter Vanpooling Act.** *Provides incentives for vanpooling programs which reduce traffic congestion, lower emissions, and save consumer fuel costs.*

- *Introduced with Rep. Russ Carnahan, Democrat from Missouri*
- *Signed into law as part of larger transportation bill (H.R. 4348)*

**[PASSED HOUSE] H.R. 3523, Cyber Intelligence Sharing and Protection Act.**

*Expands cyber threat information sharing between private sector and government to prevent cyber attacks that threaten U.S. security, economy.*

- *Introduced with Rep. Dutch Ruppersberger, Democrat from Maryland*
- *12 Democrat members joined as cosponsors*
- *Passed Intelligence Committee on a bipartisan 17-1 vote*
- *Passed House on a bipartisan 248-168 vote*

**[PASSED HOUSE] H.R. 2405, Pandemic and All-Hazards Preparedness**

**Reauthorization Act.** *Strengthens federal programs to protect the American people from a bioterrorism attack*

- *Introduced with Rep. Gene Green, Democrat from Texas*
- *Passed by voice vote in the House*

**H.R. 639, Currency Reform for Fair Trade Act.** *Cracks down on illegal Chinese currency manipulation which threatens Michigan manufacturing jobs.*

- *Introduced by Rep. Sander Levin, Democrat from Michigan*
- *Coauthored by Rep. Rogers*

**H.R. 995, Smart Technologies for Communities Act.** *Expands the use of Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) which improve auto and transportation safety.*

- *Introduced by Rep. Russ Carnahan, Democrat from Missouri*
- *Coauthored by Rep. Rogers*

**H.R. 1206, Access to Professional Health Insurance Advisors Act.** *Protects the jobs of health insurance agent and brokers from a misguided regulation included in the health reform law.*

- *Introduced with Rep. John Barrow, Democrat from Georgia*
- *20 Democrat members have cosponsored*

**H.R. 1360, Child Protection Improvements Act.** *Creates a nationwide volunteer background check system for non-profit organizations working with children.*

- *Introduced by Rep. Adam Schiff, Democrat from California*
- *Coauthored by Rep. Rogers*

**H.R. 2335, Comprehensive Problem Gambling Act.** *Improves federal programs designed to research, prevent, and treat the harmful consequences of pathological and problem gambling*

- *Introduced by Rep. James Moran, Democrat from Virginia*
- *Coauthored by Rep. Rogers*
