Friday Seminar Instructor and Guest Speakers: Participants meet every Friday at Meadows Learning Center (Avondale Schools) from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. to learn about the American educational system. Faculty is needed, both full and part-time, that are willing to share their expertise as guest speakers or in private consulting sessions.
