Meetings: the committee met on October 9, 22, and 28, and November 7 and 8 during the Fall Semester, and in the Winter Semester the committee met on January 19, February 4 and 14, and April 9. Each meeting lasted approximately two hours. The business conducted by the committee is summarized on the attached report prepared by the Office of Research Administration.

Funding Student Applications: For a number of years, the URC has funded student applications for travel and research. For this purpose, Oakland has placed \$4,000 at the disposal of the University Research Committee. This year, the amount funded totaled \$20,033. The balance of funding has been drawn from the funds negotiated in the faculty contract with Oakland University, restricted to only faculty represented by the bargaining agreement. The

committee established a subcommittee of four members, in order to make a determination regarding these funds. The subcommittee found that the URC cannot use faculty-negotiated funds to support student grants, since this violates the faculty contract (paragraph 168 states the following: "Faculty research fellowships and grants shall be awarded only to bargaining unit members for the support of their research or other scholarly/creative activities deemed appropriate by the University Research Committee."). The funding of student research and or travel beyond the \$4,000 specifically budgeted to that purpose would be contingent upon other sources of funding. The subcommittee recommends that the Research web site be modified to reflect these limitations.
