Students must register at least 48 hours prior to the start of the class. Each class has a minimum required enrollment that must be reached prior to the first session to avoid cancellation.

CHANGES IN REGISTRATION

Students/Parents must complete a Tuition Refund/Withdrawal form available in Pre-College Programs (106 NFH). Withdrawal or refund requests are not accepted by phone. There is a \$10 processing charge for all course withdrawals.

Refund amounts are based upon the day the request is received (Tuition Refund/Withdrawal form or in writing). Withdrawals prior to the start of classes are 100 percent refundable; withdrawals after the first class meeting and before the second class are 90 percent refundable. No refunds will be granted after the second class meeting. Full tuition is refunded if a course is cancelled by Oakland University. Otherwise, charges are not refunded. Refunds take approximately 2-4 weeks to process through the business office.
