FORMAL CEREMONY SCHEDULED FOR CADET ENGINEERING PROGRAM

An official announcement will be made today (Thursday) on the establishment of a pilot program within Upward Bound-Oakland in an effort to increase the number of disadvantaged students entering into engineering careers. Known as Cadet Engineering, the program takes high school students at the completion of ninth grade, brings them to the campus for a six-week summer session, and continues with the student's pre-college preparation until graduation from high school. The first group of students, who began the program at the start of the current Summer School session, are being instructed by Professors Glenn Jackson and Gilbert Wedekind in the School of Engineering. Official announcement of the new program was scheduled to be made at a brief ceremony this morning in North Foundation Hall, prsided over by Chancellor Donald D. O'Dowd, Special Projects Director Manuel Pierson, and Dr. Leonard Spearman, chief of the Division of Student Services of the U.S. Office of Education in Washington, D.C.
