Hispanic Celebration kick-off set for Sept. 17

The opening ceremony for OU's Hispanic Celebration 2001 is being held Monday, Sept. 17, from noon to 1 p.m. in the **Oakland Center** Fireside Lounge. State Rep. Belda Garza, 8th District, is the keynote speaker. There also will be refreshments, giveaways and entertainment by "Folklorico."

Hispanic Celebration 2001, which runs Sept. 15 through Oct.5, is being held in conjunction with National Hispanic Heritage Month (Sept. 15 to Oct. 15).

Many events are scheduled to celebrate and inform students, as well as the general public, about Hispanic culture. Activities include a tastefest featuring a variety of ethnic dishes; a craft night where you can design your own set of maracas; discussions on Latinos in high education and Latin politics; a presentation on children who grow up in bilingual homes; and a panel discussion on what the term "Hispanic" means to students.

New to the celebration is the Latin Rhythms Night, where traditional dance performances, a dance floor and live Latin music will be featured. A student essay contest with a first prize of \$500 also has been added.

In the last few years, Hispanic Celebration has become a tradition at OU. The event has brought Oakland students, faculty and staff together to celebrate the influence of Hispanic culture in our communities, to recognize the achievements of Hispanics and to deepen our appreciation for diversity.
