The registrar's office reports there are 562 more students ENROLLMENT AT 1,716 on campus this summer than there were in 1969. The total headcount of 1,716 includes 1,349 returning students, 660 of whom are graduate students, plus 142 first-term freshmen, 87 new transfers, 23 re-admits, and 115 quest students. A couple other short-term programs to begin later in the summer will boost the final headcount, the registrar's office noted.
