



Oakland University: Collaboration Spells Success



Researchers like Abraham R. Liboff, professor of physics, are pursuing discoveries that may change the way we live.

Oakland University — like its cultural offerings through the Meadow Brooks — is refining its role to face the promise and challenges of the 21st Century.

Just as the Meadow Brooks secure their niche in the cultural life of the community, Oakland University works to continue and strengthen its service to the academic, social and economic publics within southeastern Michigan.

The most recent initiative taken during the 10-year tenure of President Joseph E. Champagne builds on earlier studies he ordered to look at the academic mission and campus programs.

Now, the OU Senate under Champagne's direction has prepared strategic guidelines to strengthen the university. Those guidelines have been accepted by the Board of Trustees and that body prepares a final report on university planning and program priorities.

President Champagne says the Senate report calls for focusing efforts and resources on three areas: academic excellence, including faculty, students, staff and facilities; cultural diversity, including creating programs and an environment to encourage and aid students in living and working in a multicultural environment; and collaboration, through continuing and expanding its efforts with area businesses, government agencies, hospitals, schools, and civic, professional and labor organizations.

The guidelines also cite OU's strengths in faculty accomplishments in teaching, research, and community service, a quality staff, and special initiatives like the Honors College and King/Parks/ Chavez programs for minorities.

In accepting the OU Senate document, President Champagne also strongly encourages the role of research at the university. He supports the critical need to allocate resources properly to maintain quality in whatever the university attempts and supports efforts to increase all possible mutual sensitivity to and respect for members of all cultures.


And it is in collaboration that OU can make another distinctive contribution to the community, the president feels, as OU uses its knowledge base and students to work mutually with segments of the business and general community.

Just as the Meadow Brooks provide a vital service to improve the quality of life in the community, the university's academic and continuing education programs offer equally vital services, the president maintains.


Examples of the university's numerous collaborative efforts undertaken by schools and colleges, centers

and institutes and so valued by President Champagne, are listed below:

- More than a dozen programs link OU and area schools and school districts in projects including a beginning school mathematics program pioneered in New Zealand, efforts to encourage teachers and K-12 students to understand and take advantage of the cultural diversity in the classrooms, the first five-year certification program in Michigan for secondary school teachers, and a special math/science/technology high school project.
- Research in cooperating with Henry Ford Hospital to determine body composition data and weight-gain information on heart transplant patients.
- Work on stress management in cooperation with the Michigan Department of Public Health.
- Arts for Youth Camps operated in conjunction with the Oakland Schools.
- A survey of the judicial system in Oakland County and sentencing practices to help the county develop new guidelines for certain classes of offenders, as mandated by the State of Michigan.
- Work with the Industrial Technology Institute of the State of Michigan to refine computer-assisted simulations devices for efficient development of manufacturing plants and processes.
- Collaboration between OU faculty and students and the Ford Motor Company in statistical quality control.
- Joint research between OU and William Beaumont Hospital as part of a national study of age-related eye diseases (cataract and macular degeneration) to be financed over a decade through the National Eye Institute.
- A cooperative program between OU and neurologists at Henry Ford Hospital providing unequaled experiences for doctoral students in addition to major advances in understanding the underlying causes of migraine headaches.

- A critical RN/BDN completion program between OU and area hospitals enabling working nurses to complete their BSN degrees on-site.
- OU faculty assisting the Arab Community Center for Economic and Social Services in assessment of cardiovascular risk factors, AIDS and teen health planning.
- Area physical therapists who are minorities assisting OU as role models and tutors in a program to encourage more minorities to enter the physical therapy profession.
- Industries and individuals benefiting from OUs wellness, lifestyle and cardiac rehabilitation programs.
- Special workshops providing enhancement for women and union minorities.
- Free adult career counseling helping the unemployed of Oakland County and those considering a career change.
- Business and organizations benefiting from hundreds of students who alternate work and study in co-op experiences during their junior and senior years.
- OU interns playing a part in an award-winning program for high-risk youth offered through the county's Department of Corrections.

The examples above are only a few of the university's many outreach programs, explains President Champagne. He says this combination of scholarship, relevance and continued collaboration with the public sector are keys to the university's success.

Educating Students for the 21st Century:

Pursuing the

(Highlights of the Oakland University Senate Report on Strategic Guidelines)

Excellence — OU's tradition of academic excellence must be maintained and not be sacrificed in a premature effort to achieve other goals without adequate resources. To maintain that thrust, the university must:

- Maintain the quality, integrity and strength of academic programs.
- Continue to recruit faculty and staff of the quality which has characterized the university from its inception.
- Acquire and maintain library, computing, laboratory and instructional resources that keep pace with the needs of all academic programs as well as the level of scholarship expected of its faculty.
- Maintain the level of enrollment required to ensure the continued strength, breadth and depth of university programs through appropriate admission and retention efforts and the restructuring of scholarship and fellowship policies.
- Initiate programs distinctly responsive to documented needs and consistent with university goals, including expanding master's degree offerings, adding a few carefully selected doctoral programs and developing programs that allow students to earn within five years both baccalaureate and either master's degrees or professional certification.
- Increase the proportion of students enrolled in graduate and post-baccalaureate certification.
- Develop an assessment process which facilitates the improvement of academic and cocurricular programs.



- Strive to enhance the traditional teaching-learning process by taking advantage of new instructional methodologies and technologies. Students should be educated to use these technologies and understand the human implications of technological change.
- Cultural Diversity In order to be successful in a changing environment, OU students must learn to live and work effectively among people with cultural backgrounds different from their own. To achieve the objectives, the university must:
- Increase its emphasis on recruiting and retaining students, faculty and staff representing these diverse cultural groups. Foster an academic environment which encourages mutual sensitivity to and respect for members of all cultural groups.
- Develop an international focus that includes and transcends required course work.
- **Collaboration** Oakland must take advantage of its location by continuing and expanding its collaboration with area businesses,

government agencies, hospitals, schools and civic, labor and professional organizations. To do this, OU must:

- Explore and nurture relationships with these agencies that will enable students to gain experience through co-op programs and internships, and that will enable faculty to become involved in the community through consulting, research and teaching opportunities.
- Offer credit and noncredit courses at the Oakland Technology Park as well as at other off-campus sites.
- Continue to encourage faculty to collaborate with other researchers both inside and outside academe.

The report also identifies OU's strengths and opportunities, notably the quality and dedication of the faculty as evidenced by its record in teaching, research and other scholarly accomplishments; the quality of the university staff members; special programs like the Honors College; the Meadow Brooks (hall, theatre, festival and gallery); and the King/Parks/Chavez initiatives.



In 1964 when the Festival was a dream, the Kresge Foundation made a \$76,000 gift to the capital fund in memory of civic leader and foundation trustee, Howard C. 

NEEME JÄRVI Music Director

Neeme Jārvi began his post as 11th music director of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra on September 1, 1990, his first such position with an American symphony orchestra. Internationally acclaimed for his performances with orchestras and opera houses throughout the world, Mr. Jārvi is also one of today's most recorded conductors.

Born in Tallinn, Estonia, in 1937, he graduated from the Tallinn Music School with degrees in percussion and choral conducting, and later completed his studies in opera and symphonic conducting at the Leningrad State Conservatory. He made his conducting debut at the age of 18 with a concert performance of Strauss' *Night in Venice* and his operatic debut with *Carmen* at the Kirov Theater. In 1963 he became director of the Estonian Radio and Television Orchestra, and began a 13-year tenure as chief conductor at the Tallinn Opera.

International acclaim came in 1971, when Mr. Järvi won first prize in the Conductors Competition at the Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia in Rome. This triumph led to invitations to conduct major orchestras throughout Eastern Europe, Great Britain, Germany, Sweden, Japan, Mexico, and Canada. In the Soviet Union he became chief conductor and artistic director of the Estonian State Symphony and also conducted the Soviet premiere performances of Der Rosenkavalier, Porgy and Bess, and Il turco in Italia.

In January 1980, Mr. Järvi immigrated to the United States, and in the following month made his American debut with the New York Philharmonic. Since then he has conducted the major orchestras in North America and Europe, and has served as principal guest conductor with the City of Birmingham (England) Symphony (1981-83). He has served as music director of the Scottish National Orchestra (1981-88), of which he presently serves as conductor laureate, and he holds the post of principal conductor of the Gothenburg Orchestra of Sweden.

Standing in at the last minute for an ailing Seiji Ozawa, Mr. Järvi recently led the Boston Symphony Orchestra in performances at Sym-

phony Hall in Boston, as well as an exciting concert in New York's Carnegie Hall. Equally renowned for his opera conducting, Mr. Järvi made his Metropolitan Opera debut with Eugene Onegin during the 1978-79 season and returned during 1985-86 to conduct a new production of Khovanschchina. His first performances in Detroit were on tour with the Metropolitan Opera, conducting performances of Samson et Dalila.

Mr. Järvi has recorded many award winning discs for Chandos, BIS, Orfeo, and Deutsche Grammophon, including releases with the Chicago Symphony, Scottish National Orchestra, London Symphony, London Philharmonic, Bamberg Symphony, Gothenburg Symphony, and Bavarian Radio Symphony Orchestra. With the Detroit Symphony, Mr. Järvi is in the process of recording five discs for Chandos over the next two seasons, the first released in May is now available.

Awards received by Mr. Järvi include honorary doctorates from the University of Aberdeen in Scotland and the Music Conservatory of Tallinn, Estonia. An honorary member of the Swedish Academy of Music, Neeme Järvi was dubbed a Knight Commander of the North Star Order by the King of Sweden in September 1990.

Detroit Symphony Orchestra History

The Detroit Symphony Orchestra began a new era in the 1990-91 season with its new music director, Neeme Järvi; the completion of the final phase of Orchestra Hall's restoration; and the signing of a two-year five-disc recording contract with Chandos Records, the first disc released in May 1991. Last season, the Orchestra celebrated its 76th season with a move back to its original home, Orchestra Hall. The recent merger of two of Detroit's most prestigious musical institutions the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and Orchestra Hall, enables the resulting Detroit Symphony Orchestra Hall to offer a wider diversity activities as it strives to be a source of enjoyment, enrichment, education, and pride to citizens throughout the state of Michigan and beyond.

The 101 members of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra are heard liby over 350,000 people annually, performing year-round concerts the include 24 weeks of classical subscription concerts, a Weekender Poperies, an annual Christmas Festival featuring the Nutcracker ballet, Detroit News Young People's Concerts, a seven-week summer season the Meadow Brook Musical Festival, and annual tours throughout the state of Michigan. Among the educational and community concerts the Orchestra presents are free summer concerts in Detroit metropolitan parks, a free Educational Concert Series, free Detroit Symphony Civic Orchestra concerts, two Classical Roots concerts, well as the annual Unisys African-American Composers Forum.

The Detroit Symphony Orchestra continues its long history of national radio broadcasts that includes participation in the first complete symphonic radio broadcast (1922). That same year it became the first official radio broadcast orchestra in the nation. As a recording ensemble, the Detroit Symphony Orchestra has a distinguished hist that includes award-winning discs on the Chandos, London, RCA, and Mercury Records labels.
