Medical Physics Graduate Publishes Dissertation in Stroke

Kishor Karki graduated from Oakland University in 2008 with a PhD in **Biomedical Sciences: Medical Physics**. In the October 2009 issue of the journal **Stroke**, Karki published part of his dissertation research: **Simvastatin** and **Atorvastatin** Improve Neurological Outcome After Experimental **Intracerebral Hemorrhage (Volume 40, Pages 3384-3389)**. Karki's mentors were Adjunct faculty member **Robert Knight** (himself a 1991 graduate of the OU medical physics program) and Distinguished Professor **Mike Chopp**. The research looked at the use of statins (commonly known as Zocor and Lipitor) to improve the recovery from a **stroke**.
