## Mark Your Calendar – Important Financial Aid Reminder

While it might seem too early to be thinking about financial aid for next year, it's not! Beginning on January 1, 2009, students are able to complete their **FAFSA** (financial aid application) online to

apply for financial aid for the 2009-2010 academic year. An early and accurate application ensures the fullest consideration for financial aid, which is generally awarded on a first-come, first-served basis as funding is available. If you have not yet completed your tax returns when you fill out the FAFSA, you can provide estimated income information and then update the information when your taxes are filed. If you have a renewable scholarship, review the renewal criteria to ensure you are meeting your scholarship renewal requirements. If you are eligible for the Michigan Competitive Scholarship, your FAFSA must be received by the processor by March 1, 2009.
